Youth Choral Scholarship Information

The GSCS Youth Choral Scholarship was created to encourage and support students who desire to sing as a member of this exciting community choir. There are three levels of awards; each providing different support.

Award	Level of Support	Value (approximate)
Gold	Covers the cost of membership, attire and music	\$250
Silver	Covers the cost of membership and music	150
Bronze	Covers cost of music	50

<u>Requirements</u> – The scholarship is for a full season; depending on application date (Jan-Dec or Sept-Aug). Applicants must be full or part-time students (public, private, or home) and at least 12, but not more than 22 years of age on the date of the first rehearsal. Singing experience is not required, but application must include a recommendation describing the student's interest or current activity in musicianship and capacity for participation.

<u>Expectations</u> – Recipients of the GSCS Youth Choral Scholarships will be expected to participate fully as a member of the choir for the season; meeting or surpassing the GSCS standards for attendance, participation, and performance (according to the GSCS Member Contract). It is also expected that recipients will be good ambassadors of the chorale by sharing and promoting its vision and mission with family, friends, and others.

<u>Procedure</u> – Interested students that meet the requirements as described should download or otherwise obtain the official Scholarship Application and provide all of the requested information. Application will not be considered complete until receive 1) a brief letter/essay describing the applicant's qualification for the scholarships, and 2) a letter from one of the applicant's references endorsing the applicant's musical capacity. All paperwork must be submitted and received **no later than Sept 9, 2019.** Mail it to the attention of Scholarship Committee, at the address above. Or scan and email to gschoral@gmail.com

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and announcements of the recipients will be made no later than Sept 16, 2019. Formal concerts are planned for November 23 &24, 2019 and spring 2020 concerts will be April 25 & 26. Other singing opportunities will be announced as planned.
